Heritage Week at a glance in County Wicklow... travelling north to south

Blessington has a busy Heritage Week this year with historical talks and launches, World & Traditional Music and a display on the Blessington Currachs. Nearby, Russborough is the magnificent setting for a free tour of the Demesne and West Wing or to try your hand at Blacksmithing. At Hollywood the focus will be on pre 1950's country life, with two days of music, crafts, céilí and games see www.thehollywoodfair. com. **Bray** is a hive of heritage activity whether you are interested in Whale Watching or historical talks on or The Week That Was 1913 or as a special treat find out more about St Peters Graveyard in Little Bray and some of its more notable occupants. The libraries in Wicklow will all be hosting 'Wicklow Reminiscences', a chance for you to tell your story for inclusion in the County Wicklow Community Heritage Archive. Beautiful **Glencree** will be celebrating the Oak Glen forest with family activities organised by Crann. Take part in a heritage walking tour of beautiful Enniskerry village, or at nearby **Powerscourt Estate** take your pick from Vintage Cars, Miniature Hat Making or Children's Storytelling. At Greystones get your egg and spoon out as part of the Vintage Sports Day in the Burnaby Heritage Weekend, featuring talks, guided tours, musical entertainment as well as a unique historical photographic exhibition. Greystones Historic Carnegie library is





the setting for the launch of the OS Letters of Counties Wicklow and Carlow, a new publication from Four Masters Press. **Delgany** lives up to its Heritage Village reputation once more with a guided tour of the medieval graveyard and a tour of the Heritage **Trail.** South of **Kilmacanogue** take some time to visit Calary church, see the John Nelson Darby pulpit, have a cup of tea and some local country produce. **Newcastle** has something for everyone with Family Nature walks with Birdwatch Ireland at East Coast Nature Reserve or enjoy hearing all about the Story of Wicklow's Gold Rush of 1795 with Peadar McArdle. For garden lovers and budding botanists Mount Usher Gardens in Ashford will have a guided garden tour, Knocknaree near Avoca will have an 'Open Garden' and Kilmacurragh **Botanic Gardens** will have a series of free wildflower walks, talks and family days out. The centre of the county, **Glendalough** will also be a centre for a host of heritage activity including a combined archaeological and natural heritage guided walks and an exploration of Wicklow's mining links with Cumbria in England in a special historical genealogical talk organised by Glens Of Lead.



Wicklow Town will host a photography exhibition on Wicklow's Living Wetlands in County Buildings, coastal walks and the ever popular Open Day at Wicklow Head



Lighthouse, while Wicklow's Historic Gaol will be offering half price admission. Closeby, the **Ballymurrin Farmhouse**, a 17th century house, now a family home will be open for guided visits, a unique opportunity to find out about its fascinating Quaker heritage. The Copper Mining landscape of Avoca will be explored, explained and brought to life by mining enthusiast Nick Coy. A special event this year will be the chance to visit the grounds of **Carnew Castle** and find out more about the wonderful history of Carnew town and surrounding area with an exhibition and display. As ever there will be a host of events in **Arklow** throughout the week, from Bat Walks to Family Fun walks, a Maritime Talks, World Music and **Stone Age Art.**
