The earliest reference to Old Commaught noted by me, is that in archbishop Allen's Register, c.1172-154, Royal Society of Antiqueries (2:itor McHeill). This sentions Old Commaught (Celluca - Kituc in Shanganagh Gastle grounds) as being one of the perished of the Diocese of Dublin in 1179.

Rev R.S. Maffett, B.A., writing in the J. Memorials association, vol. 'The centre memorial is a flat stone, the sides of which rest on low blocks of grantie. At the bend of the stone, in each course, there is a charub carved in relief. Inside the text, which is placed in the form of an inverted block U, an inside line forms a lorsego, in the omnts of which is a cross, with an interlaced S on the main shaft, and resting on an H low down, a 2 being in the upper center angle of the lorsego; at the sides of the cross are respectively J.N. and R.J. The lettering is in ordinary eachilist.
